TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION PROCEDURE

Your curbside trash and recycling service is provided by your HOA and serviced by GFL Environmental.

If you have recently purchased a new home and have not received your GFL trash and recycling containers, please contact the community manager to arrange for service setup and container delivery.

Trash pickup is weekly on Friday

Recycling pickup is every other Friday

- All trash (bagged and sealed please) should be placed inside the rolling cart
- All recyclable materials should be placed in your cart clean and loose
- Please place carts curbside the night before your scheduled service day and take them back by that evening
- Holiday schedule: There is no service on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. Your pick-up for that week will run one day behind.

751 South Rules and Regulations regarding trash/recycling:

- a. If trash and recycle bins are not kept in garages of single family homes, they must be placed at the rear of the home. Trash and recycle bins may be stored within an enclosure of not less than 5' tall. These enclosures can be constructed utilizing fencing material that is complimentary to the home. Landscaping/planting may also be utilized to screen the bins from view.
- b. Trash and recycling bins for townhome units may be placed in the mulch, directly against the structure, under the deck and on either side of the rear load garage door.
- c. Trash enclosures may be placed in the side and rear yards. If a fence is provided, it shall match the design of other fences on the lot.
- d. Prior approval of the AAC is required for the installation of any of the items described in items a and c.
- e. Trash and recycling bins may be placed at the end of driveway for collection the night before scheduled pick up and must be returned to the proper storage location the evening of pick up.
