BULKY ITEM COLLECTION PROCEDURE

Regular trash and recycling collection in 751 South is provided by GFL Environmental at the Association's expense. However, bulky item collection is handled separately by the City of Durham and must be arranged by the homeowner directly with the City of Durham.

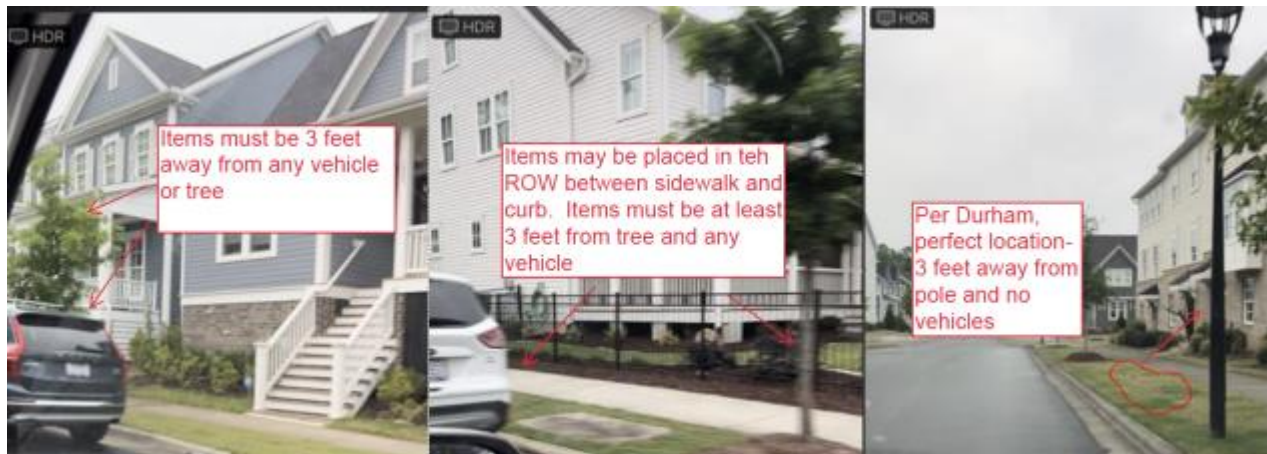

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

Where & When to Place Bulky Items for Pickup

- **Timing:** Bulky items may be placed out no more than 24 hours before your scheduled pickup time.
- **Location:** Items must be placed in the public right-of-way between the sidewalk and curb, at least three (3) feet away from any:
 - Light poles
 - Trees
 - Fire hydrants
 - Utility pedestals
 - Other obstructions
- **Parking Considerations:** No vehicles should be parked near the bulky items. The City of Durham provided sample photos of acceptable staging areas (see below).



Additional Guidelines from the City of Durham:

- Bulky items are collected mechanically using a boom truck.
- **Placement Restrictions:** Do not place items under low-hanging wires or tree limbs.
- **Obstruction Warning:** Do not cover or block:
 - Water meters
 - Fire hydrants
 - Telephone boxes
 - Underground sprinklers
 - Decorative stones or other valuables that could be damaged
- **Alleys:** The city does not collect bulky items from alleys. All bulky items for collection must be curbside and clear of obstructions (e.g., cars, mailboxes, fences, poles).
- The collection process uses a mechanical arm, and if there is any risk of property damage, the driver will not collect the items.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

There are certain items that are prohibited from this service. Examples of these types of items include:

- Building materials
- Car parts
- Construction debris
- Dirt
- Electronics (E-waste)
- Food Scraps
- Glass / Mirrors / Windows
- Loose leaves
- Propane tanks
- Television sets
- Tires
- Tree stumps
- Wood / Pallets / Lumber

These items should be disposed of at the City's Waste Disposal and Recycling Center, 2115 East Club Boulevard.
