



## Arbor Creek Homeowners Association Parental Agreement for Children 14-17 years of age

### Arbor Creek HOA Pool Supervision Policy

Per North Carolina state guidelines, an adult must accompany children under 14 years of age.

- **Children 14-17:** May enter the pool without an adult but must show a valid student ID upon entry. If a child is home-schooled or does not have an ID, a parent or guardian must complete the verification form below.
- Unaccompanied minors ages 14-17 must be residents and live in Arbor Creek.
- Children **must** be accompanied by an adult for night swimming hours. (9 PM - 11 PM)
- Children are **not** permitted to bring guests.
- **Access Control:** Each individual must scan their household pool key for entry. Gate access should not be shared or granted to others.
- The form below must be completed and turned into a lifeguard in person with the adult and child(ren) present together.

### Parental Consent Form
