Pool Rules

Hours of Operation: 6:00 AM – 8:30 PM (*Dawn to Dusk, subject to change*)

A chair lift has been installed for residents in need of assistance to enter the pool. Access will only be granted to those with a physical need and must be supervised by an adult during operation.

If there is an EMERGENCY at the pool, dial 911 from the pool phone immediately.

By order of the **Wake County Health Department** all members and guests must adhere to the following rules. If a violation is cited, it may cause the pool to close for an extended period of time.

1. **NO GLASS** containers allowed in the pool or deck area. If broken glass is found in the pool area, the pool must be closed, totally drained, refilled, the filtration system recharged along with any other treatments required by the Wake County Board of Health. **The Homeowner responsible for this action will be charged the costs incurred.**
2. The gate to the pool area **MUST** remain closed at all times. Do not prop the gate open in any way. This violates a health regulation in Wake County and poses a very real danger to our young residents.
3. Pets are **NOT** allowed on the premises.
4. Training pants with snug fitting rubber pants or swim diapers are required for any infant/child not toilet trained. Please escort all young children to the restrooms frequent to avoid fecal incidents. Fecal contamination may cause the pool to close for up to 24 hours while water treatment is conducted. **The Homeowner responsible for this action will be charged costs incurred.**

The Board of Directors have developed the following RULES AND REGULATIONS for the protection of the community and to help ensure that every family enjoys this pool season.

1. **Children under 16 must be accompanied** by an authorized person 18 years or older. An 18-year-old may not accompany more than 3 minors to the pool at one time.
2. A homeowner must accompany guests. The homeowner is responsible for the conduct of their guests. *(limit of (6) guests per family per visit will be allowed for 2024 season)*
3. Proper swimming attire is required in the pool. Please remember this is a family environment.
4. Refrain from using the pool if you have open wounds, sores, or lesions. Band-Aids are not allowed in the pool.

A phone is available at the pool. The number is 919-263-7577. The phone may be used for local calls, 800 calls, and calling card calls, only. All other services have been blocked. Please limit calls to brief usage in case of an emergency.

Dial 911 in the event of an emergency.

5. **Rules of conduct for the pool and pool area:**
 - A. No running or horseplay allowed.
 - B. No boisterous or rough play.
 - C. No diving.
 - D. No profanity or abusive language.
 - E. No pool furniture in the pool.
 - F. No loud music.
 - G. No skateboards, bicycles, scooters, or rollerblades in the pool area.
 - H. No loitering or playing in the bathrooms or parking areas.
 - I. No chewing gum in the pool or on the deck area.
 - J. No throwing objects in the pool area.
6. Pick up your trash and leave the pool area clean.
7. **Umbrellas should be closed before you leave the area.** Strong gusts of wind may cause damage to the umbrellas if left open.
8. Bathrooms and outside shower facilities are to be left clean after use.
9. Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed by anyone under the age of 21. **NO GLASS CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND ALLOWED IN THE POOL AREA!**
10. Members and their guests will not be permitted inside the pool area or allowed to remain at the pool if intoxicated.
11. No eating or drinking **IN** the pool will be allowed.
12. No verbal abuse, cussing, profanity or similar offensive language will be tolerated in the pool or recreation area.

13. Any personal items left at the pool will be put in the LOST & FOUND. Items left in the lost and found for more than 10 days will be donated to charity.
14. Overnight parking at the pool must be approved in advance by the Board or vehicles are subject to tow.
15. There is a recycle bin located at the pool. Please place all recyclable materials in this container instead of the garbage containers.
16. Smoking inside the pool area is prohibited.
17. The use of extension cords within the pool area is prohibited.

**FAILURE TO FOLLOW ALL POOL RULES WILL RESULT IN REVOCATION OF POOL
PRIVILEGES. HOW TO ENFORCE THE RULES**

- Approach the person in a polite manner and try to resolve the problem in a neighborly way. *Most conflicts can be resolved in this manner.*
- Call or email CAS, Inc. to report violations and AMG or CAS, Inc. emergency line to report fecal incidents or glass breakage at time of incident.
- If the violation constitutes an emergency, call Sheriff – 911.
- Call the Wake County Sheriff's Department to report anyone trespassing on the premises after hours.

If everyone takes responsibility for taking care of these facilities, they will always be a source of pride within our community! Let's work together for a safe and fun pool season!
