

# GLENKIRK NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION 2024 SWIMMING POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

POOL HOURS: Dawn to Dusk, from 5:30am – 8:30pm

Please be reminded that all persons who choose to enter Glenkirk Neighborhood Assn. pool and facilities do so on a purely voluntary basis and all such persons voluntarily assume the risk of infection of COVID19 when utilizing the facilities, or when interacting with others on the Property.

**DO NOT ENTER if you or anyone in your household has a cough, fever or other symptom of illness or has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.**

1. This is a **private pool with admittance by fob** only. It is solely for the use of Glenkirk Community residents in good standing. Anyone using this facility without authorization is subject to arrest for trespassing.
2. **No lifeguard** is on duty at this pool. **Users of this pool do so at their own risk.** Neither Glenkirk Community Association, the pool maintenance company, nor the management company will be responsible for any accidents or injury in or around the pool. Use of the pool indicates acceptance of these conditions.
3. Please wash your hands frequently, at least every time you enter the restrooms, for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer, to help reduce the potential transmission of COVID-19.
4. Due to mandatory occupancy limits, each household may bring a maximum of EIGHT (8) guests to the pool.
5. **NO SMOKING, VAPING, E-CIGARETTES, etc. OF ANY KIND is permitted within the pool or pool deck area.**
6. The self-locking gate(s) must always remain closed and locked.
7. Please shower before using the pool.
8. Solo swimming by adults is strongly discouraged.
9. **Children under age 18 MUST be accompanied** by an adult (defined as someone who is 18 years old or older and is the parent or legal guardian, a relative, or baby-sitter). Unsupervised children will be required to leave the pool area.
10. Babies and children who are not completely potty trained should wear swim diapers and tight-fitting rubber pants while they are in and around the pool. Disposable or cloth diapers are not allowed.
11. No person is permitted to swim with open or infected wounds of any kind.
12. **No glass containers of any kind are permitted** in or around the pool. If broken glass is found in the pool, the pool must be closed, drained, cleaned, and refilled. These costs will be charged to the responsible homeowner.

13. Alcoholic beverages are permitted for those over the age of twenty-one (21). Consumption of alcoholic beverages is a matter of personal preference. Containers of alcohol should be kept concealed. Any person showing signs of intoxication may be denied future use of the facilities.
14. Please keep food at least 4 feet from the edge of the pool.
15. **Trash and refuse** must be placed in the proper receptacles. No trash or debris is to be thrown in the pool.
16. **Cut-off clothing** with unfinished hems is prohibited. Loose threads clog the filter/pump.
17. Running, shoving, and other forms of **horseplay** are **prohibited** in or around the pool.
18. Only **battery-operated** radios, CD players, etc. may be used at the pool. They must be played at a reasonably soft level so as not to disturb others in the pool area. Please be considerate.
19. No one may tamper with or **remove any pool equipment** or furniture.
20. **No pets** are allowed inside the pool fence at any time.
21. **Violation** of these rules may result in loss of privileges to use this facility for up to twelve months by order of the Board of Directors.
22. Damage to any of the equipment, furniture or any portion of the facility will be charged back to the responsible party/parties, as applicable.
23. **One access fob** is issued per household. Replacement fobs are \$25 each.
24. The Glenkirk Neighborhood Association Board of Directors shall have the authority, as deemed necessary, to expel anyone at any time for misbehavior, use of abusive language or apparent intoxication. Individuals expelled may not use the pool for the remainder of the day they are removed. To file a written complaint, please contact CAS, Inc.
25. The health and safety of members is ultimately their own responsibility. Anyone using the pool or related facilities has no claim against the Glenkirk Neighborhood Association for accident or injury. The Association will not be responsible for loss or damages to personal property.
